The Global Association of Risk Professionals (GARP) certification ceremony, held at Congress Hotel on 15 February was a ground breaking event for the financial sector of the RA. This prestigious event stemmed from the cooperation of GARP (a not-for-profit organization

based in USA) and IAB Centre (an Armenian training provider) and was aimed at further development of risk management in the RA. The overall goal of the RCP training program was to help risk managers in RA to develop a robust risk management culture. The event helped to generate various opinions regarding current urgent financial issues in the RA and will certainly form a keystone for future possible solutions to them.

In terms of outcomes, the risk management courses organized by IAB Centre proved to be extremely successful as 14 students out of 15 passed the RCP

examination. The ceremony which was attended by employees from financial institutions and banks in the RA, was presided over by
